Welcome to our Autumn Newsletter. It is good to be back singing with an exciting programme of concerts over the next year. Please talk to friends about joining the choir and/or the opportunity to be an extra singer for the Capernwray concert.

Music

Rehearsals 2022/23 – these will continue on Mondays, 7 – 9.20pm, with a refreshment break, at Borwick and Priest Hutton Memorial Hall (BPH). Rehearsals will continue weekly until Monday 17th May 2023 *except there will be no rehearsal on 26th December 2022 or 2nd January 2023.* All rehearsals will be at BPH except Monday 5th December when we will rehearse in Heversham Church. Ian will be rehearsing both Brahms Requiem and items for the Christmas concert during the Autumn Term with the 3rd Monday of each month devoted to Brahms and Parry to allow extra singers to have the option of attending these rehearsals. The rehearsal on 19th December will be part Brahms/Parry rehearsal and part social event which guest singers will be very welcome to attend.

Come & Sing, Saturday 10th September – 28 singers from inside and outside the choir gathered to sing some items from Brahms Requiem and VW Festival Te Deum. Thank you to lan for leading the day and to everyone who contributed in any way.

Christmas Concert, Sunday 11th December, 2.30pm, Heversham Church — this will be a combined Autumn and Christmas concert with some wonderful music for the choir as well as carols with audience participation. We will sing VW: Fantasia on Christmas Carols, from Brahms Requiem: How Lovely Are Thy Dwellings, Lauridsen: O Magnum Mysterium, and VW: Lord Thou Hast Been Our Refuge. Ian Pattinson will accompany the choir on organ.

• Brahms Requiem, Saturday 25th February, 2.30pm, Capernwray Hall — we are delighted to return to this fabulous venue with great acoustics and space. The choir will also sing Parry: Blest Pair of Sirens, and the orchestra will play Parry: Elegy for Brahms. There will be a rehearsal with the orchestra at 10am on the same day with time to rest and have lunch before the performance. We're delighted that at least 9

extra singers are joining us for this event. Midi files to assist us in learning the music have already been forwarded and there are other free rehearsal aids such as Cyberbass. The Halle are organising a 'Come and Sing with the Halle' event on the Brahms Requiem, at the Bridgewater Hall on Saturday 4 February 2023. This is open to all and will consist of daytime rehearsals and a performance with the Halle Orchestra in the evening. They will sing it in German, rather than our English version, but it is still a great opportunity for further study of the work so close to our Capernwray concert. We are currently investigating the possibility of organising transport to the event. If you might be interested in attending, please let Maggie or Janet Clements know.

Spring Concert, Saturday 20th May, 7.30pm at BPH – the programme will include Carter: Benedicite (with children's choir) and Chilcott: Aesop's Fables
